Javier Hidalgo, Sanlucar de Barrameda, Spain. (abv 15%) Fresher and fruitier than ever. This Manzanilla is elegant, pungent and nutty with a delightful tangy salty finish. The perfect way to start your evening.

AMONTILLADO DELGADO ZULETA [Medium dry sherry]

Delgado Zuleta, Andalucia, Spain (abv 17.5%)

Wonderful, intensely complex Amontillado which is not completely dry. Concentrated, salty, nutty flavours are the result of long ageing in old soleras, within sight of the sea.

OLOROSO ABOCADO 'Alameda' [Cream sherry]

Javier Hidalgo, Bodegas Hidalgo, Sanlucar de Barrameda, Spain (abv 18%)
For those looking for a sweeter Oloroso, the Abocado is a blend of old soleras with high-quality Pedro Ximenez; it is dark and concentrated with a very long finish. These are all sherries which represent the most traditional side of the market and are the purest examples of what the Jerezanos drink themselves.

DRY WHITE PORT £9.45

Churchill Graham, Vila Nova de Gaia, Porto, Portugal (abv 19.5%)
This is a White Port that makes a statement. Full flavoured with a dry nutty finish, its naturally rich, golden colour is the result of 10 years' ageing in wood. The extent of extra ageing gives the white port a balance and smoothness which puts it firmly in a class of its own. Served chilled. Stunning!

Whites

1. TREBI, Trebbiano d'Abruzzo 2021

Talamonti, Loreta Aprutino, Abruzzo (abv 12.5%) A delightful bouquet of ripe apples and peaches translates on to the palate where the refreshing fruit ends in gentle acidity. A rich, well-rounded wine made from 100% Trebbiano d'Abbruzzo.

2. SAUVIGNON BLANC 2021

Lanark Lane, Marlborough, New Zealand (abv 13%)
Intensely aromatic, crisp and fresh, reflecting the world famous
Marlborough style. Upfront and zesty, it shows typical gooseberry and
tropical fruit with attractive herbaceous notes and a lingering finish.
Leafy, tree lined Lanark Lane runs from Marlborough's West Coast Road
down to a precious vineyard, planted exclusively in Sauvignon Blanc.

MUSCADET Sevre et Maine sur Lie, 2021

Domaine de la Bretonnière, Le Landreau, Loire, France (abv 12%) A truly memorable Muscadet from one of the most highly-regarded villages in the region. Pale in colour with distinctive white flower and green apple aromas. The palate is hyper-fresh and crisp yet with a wonderful richness and a great depth of fruit.

4. CHARDONNAY Reserva, 2020

Casas del Bosque, Casablanca, Chile (abv 13%)
An intense, fruit driven Chardonnay from cool climate vineyards in Chile.
On the nose aromas of walnut, ripe pear and quince dominate. In the mouth a citrus backbone is fleshed-out by ample mineral and peach notes finishing with a very subtle smoky note. A short spell in oak adds to the complexity of this excellent, full-bodied Chardonnay.

5. TEJO ROSÉ PINOT NOIR, 2021/22 £7.00 £10.50 £30.50

Quinta do Casal Monteiro, Tejo, Portugal (abv 12.5%) Charming pale pink rosé, crisp and dry with abundant red berry aromas and lovely fresh finish.

3. ROSÉ PINOT NOIR, 2021 £7.50 £11.00 £32.50

Villa Wolf, Rheinhessen, Germany (abv 11.5%)
Hints of rhubarb and raspberry on the nose, off-dry, yet rich and
full flavoured, with a creamy texture and a splash of strawberry essence
running through the middle.

Reds

7. 'LES VOLIERES' OLD VINE CARIGNAN, 2020 £7.00 £10.50 £30.50

IGP Pays d'Hérault, France (abv 12.5%)
Made from carefully selected fruit from 40 year old vines, Carignan is
very typical of this part of southern France but is rarely seen on its own –
more often used in blends with varieties such as Grenache, Syrah & Cinsault.
Modern wine-making techniques result in a very fruit-driven style with hints
of spice, tobacco & ripe red berry aromas. The palate is soft and silky with masses
of juicy fruit and just a touch of the earthiness so typical of this area.

8. 'STABLEMATE' Merlot 2019 £7.50 £11.00 £32.50

Excelsior Estate, Robertson, South Africa (abv 14.5%)
A lovely rich and velvety Merlot with plenty of rich, ripe fruit and some subtle oak ageing. Lush cherry and plum characters backed up by smoky coffee and spice notes and a soft, supple texture.

9. CABERNET FRANC Fantasia, 2018 £8.00 £11.50 £33.50

Bodegas Mauricio Lorca, Vista Flores, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina (abv 14%) This really delivers with its delicious sour cherry and juicy strawberry flavours with all the typicity and fruit purity of Cabernet Franc that the Loire growers can often only dream of. Only 30% aged in oak, resulting in a hint of oak on the nose along with white pepper, and a hint of capsicum. Soft and juicy, with excellent balancing acidity.

10. SHIRAZ 'Selkirk', 2019 £8.00 £11.50 £33.50

Bremerton, Langhorne Creek, South Australia (abv 14.5%)
Selkirk Shiraz offers distinctive varietal characters of lifted white pepper aroma, dark berry fruit, plum and savoury spice. Balanced and well-structured with soft supple tannins and well integrated oak all make a delicious, satisfying wine.



White Wines

11. SHORELINE, 2021 £34.95

Lyme Bay Winery, Axe Valley, Devon, UK

A wine for seafood, deliciously fresh and crisp with subtle notes of citrus fruits on the palate, and herbaceous hints. Made in Devon from Seyval Blanc, Bacchus, and Pinot Blanc grapes. AWARD: Silver Medal, Decanter Wine Awards, May 2015

12. CHABLIS, 2021 £44.95

Domaine Pinson, Chablis, France

Bright, vibrant, pure, refreshing, aromatic, loaded with 'goût de pierre à fusil' (gunflint taste), and perfectly balanced between ripe fruit and lemony, green apple, acidity.

13. VERMENTINO di Sardegna, 2021

£33.95

Costamolino, Argiolas Estate, Cagliari, Sardinia

Subtle, delicate and beautifully dry, this Vermentino is, we think, outstanding. Argiolas personifies Sardinia, due in part to the family's devotion to indigenous Sardinian grape varieties. Their passion is shared by the famous oenologist Professor Giacomo Tachis, the father of prestigious Italian wines such as Sassicaia, Tignanello and Solaia, who has worked closely with the Argiolas family for over a decade now.

14. DART VALLEY RESERVE, 2021

£34.50

Sharpham Vineyards, Totnes, Devon

Off-dry, ever popular, elegant white from South Devon. Made from Madeleine Angevine, Chardonnay and Bacchus grapes grown on the banks of the River Dart. This is a great aperitif wine and an ideal accompaniment to fish.

15. SAUVIGNON BLANC, 2021

Paul Cluver Estate, Elgin, South Africa

Only the best quality grapes are used for making the Paul Cluver Sauvignon Blanc.

A refreshing wine, with expressive aromas of grapefruit, gooseberry and suggestions of blackcurrant all follow through onto the palate, which has a lovely creamy texture from lees contact and the

16. ALBARINO Gran Fabian, 2021

£35.95

Bodegas Viña Sobreira, Pontevedra, Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain

From a family-owned winery situated in a beautiful location on the coast (some outstanding surf beaches are only 5 miles away) where the Salnes Valley meets the Atlantic. This is a very fresh Albarino with white peach, melon and citrus flavours, leading to a superb mineral 'kick' on the finish.

17. THE REAL McCOY RIESLING, 2021

£33.95

Jordan Wine Estate, Stellenbosch, South Africa

Grown on the unique south-east facing cooler aspect, these vines are 30 years old and grown in decomposed granite soil. This sensitive and aromatic variety has been made with a hint of natural sugars and wonderful intense flavours of lime through to white peach and green apple. The balancing acidity makes it a perfect match to foods with some spice & white fish dishes. Utterly divine with crab and shellfish.

18. VIOGNIER, 2021 £32.95

Domaine Saint Hilaire, Pays d'Oc, France

St. Hilaire's Viognier vines are over 20 years old, planted long before this variety was fashionable - the resulting wine is alluringly exotic with aromas of ripe apricots, peaches and honeysuckle. The palate exudes lush and unctuous fruit flavours beautifully balanced with a clean, mineral freshness.



White Wines

Richer, more complex whites

19. RIOJA BLANCO Lopez de Haro, 2020/21

£32.50

Bodega Classica, Rioja Alta, Spain

Made from 100% Viura grapes, this is a truly modern style of unoaked white Rioja offering the best of both worlds: full, ripe apple and peach fruit overlaid with a clean, crisp acidity and a lovely silky texture.

20. FIANO DEL SALENTO 'Acante', 2020

£32.95

Castello Monaci, Salento, Italy

Fiano is one of the most prestigious grape varieties of southern Italy. Intense perfumes of fruit and honey lead into fresh, lively flavours and a smooth finish of toasted hazelnut, enhanced by low temperature fermentation and ageing on its own yeasts.

21. BOURGOGNE BLANC, 2020

£42.50

Domaine Hudelot-Baillet, Burgundy, France

Joël Hudelot and his wife, Chantal Baillet, created the domaine in 1981 with 35 vineyard plots dotted about 8 hectares, including two Grand Cru and twenty-two Premier Cru site This wine is every bit as rich and vibrantly fruity as many a more expensive Cote de Beaune. It is quite weighty for its humble appellation and has an unctuous, toasty, buttery fruitiness.

22. PINOT GRIS, 2021 £34.95

Domaine Henry Fuchs, Ribeauvillé, Alsace, France

Exceptional Pinot Gris from a tiny, family-run organic producer in Alsace. There is a touch of honeyed sweetness with a rich mouthfeel, yet still fresh with smoky undertones. Lovely long length with balanced acidity and alcohol. Very rich even by Alsace Pinot Gris standards with a relatively high degree of residual grape sugars on the palate. This really is artisan winemaking. Another must-try.

23. VOUVRAY Demi-Sec, Peu de la Moriette, 2019

£39.95

Domaine Pichot, Touraine, Loire, France

A truly memorable medium dry Vouvray, packed with pure, vibrant apple and peach fruit and with a wonderfully refreshing, perfect balanced acidity and a surprisingly complex, honeyed finish. Produced from careful winemaking by father and son team at this highly regarded vineyard.

24. CHARDONNAY, 'LE BARON' 2018

£40.95

Domaine Saint Hilaire, Montagnac, Pays d'Oc, France

A sumptuous, rich, barrel-fermented Chardonnay from this picturesque and historic estate tucked away in the beautiful Hérault countryside. Named after the first Baron, Hilaire Reynaud, 'Chardonnay Le Baron' is made from hand-picked grapes carefully selected from the best parcels of 30 -35 year old vines which have exceptionally low yields and give intensely flavoured, concentrated juice. Delicately floral aromas of garrigue honey, lead to a palate of brioche typical of a Chardonnay resulting from a long ageing. This artisanal wine seduces with its elegance comparable to the great Burgundian wines.

25. PULIGNY MONTRACHET, 2020

£69.95

Domaine Jean-Louis Chavy, Puligny, Burgundy, France Finely balanced and pure, with an exotic floral-fruit nose, great intensity and richness yet with a fresh acidity. All testament to the scrupulous attention to detail and desire for low yields exhibited by Jean-Louis, whose reputation for great Puligny is well deserved.

5. TEJO ROSÉ, 2021

Quinta do Casal Monteiro, Tejo, Portugal

Charming pale pink rosé, crisp and dry with abundant red berry aromas and lovely fresh finish.

6. ROSÉ PINOT NOIR, 2021

Villa Wolf, Rheinhessen, Germany

Hints of rhubarb and raspberry on the nose, off-dry, yet rich and full flavoured, with a creamy texture and a splash of strawberry essence running through the middle.

26. CHATEAU CAVALIER 'Cuvée Marafiance', 2020/21

Côtes de Provence, France

An opulent blend of Grenache, Syrah, Rolle, Cinsault, Sémillon & Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose is complex and refined with notes of citrus and red fruit and floral, spicy aromas. The palate shows good structure and finesse. Flavours of red fruit and citrus, developing floral and mineral notes. A truly elegant wine. 91/100 James Suckling. Gold Medal: Concours des Vins de Provence 2017

27. FLEURIE, 2020

£38.50

Chateau de la Chaize, Beaujolais, France

Intense, brilliant garnet red in colour. On the nose, finesse and elegance with notes of dried flowers and very ripe red fruits, and delicate tannins on the palate flowing into a salivating finish. All in all a silky, soft Fleurie with real precision and underlying concentration, giving it great length.

28. PINOT NOIR, 'Serbal' 2021

£33.95

Bodegas Atamisque, Tupungatao, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina With this wine, it's all about the fruit, no oak, and pure varietal character. Elegant, poised with a very fruity nose offering overtones of cherry and strawberry. A soft, velvety palate with a suggestion of smokiness and a good fruity finish. A delightful Pinot Noir that would give low-end Burgundy a run for its money.

29. BEAUNE 1er CRU, 'Vignes Franches, 2020

£49.95

Château de la Charrière, Domaine Yves Girardin, Burgundy, France Deep ruby in colour with pleasant aromas of cherries, red fruits and hints of vanilla. Smooth and delicious with a full and lively palate where spice gently augments the fruits. There is an exuberance to this wine which evolves into a persistent finish.



Red Wines

Medium bodied, fruit driven reds

30. CÔTES DU RHÔNE Cuvée Nature, 2020/21

£34.95

Domaine Roche-Audran, Buisson, Southern Rhone, France

A deliciously fresh and silky Grenache/Syrah blend from the <u>Organic</u> and <u>Biodynamic</u> estate of talented Rhône winemaker, Vincent Rochette. Packed full of vibrant berry fruit infused with garrigue herbs, the 'Cuvée Nature' undergoes a long, slow vinification before being bottled in the spring with <u>no added Sulphur</u> to preserve the flavour and freshness of this cuvée.

31. CHATEAU BÉARD LA CHAPELLE, 2014

£43.50

Grand Cru St Emilion, Chateau Béard la Chapelle, Bordeaux, France

Complex nose of gingerbread, black cherry, rose, mint and cocoa. Rich and rounded, full-bodied and concentrated with spice, kirsch and bitter chocolate on the finish. This 18 hectare estate is a Grand Cru St Emilion appellation which stipulates a planting density of only 5,500 vines per hectare and a maximum yield of 49 hectolitres per hectare. This yield is one of the lowest in Bordeaux and forces producers to limit the production of each vine, ensuring the harvested grapes are more concentrated in colour and flavour.

32. CHURCHILL'S ESTATES DOURO, 2018

£34.50

Churchill Graham, Douro Valley, Portugal

Hand crafted and individual this wine is made from hand-picked Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz and Touriga Franca varieties. This top-quality red is far removed from Shiraz and Cabernet - soft and very approachable with masses of full-flavoured summer berry fruits, a judicious touch of oak and ripe, soft tannins. Very food friendly, especially with weighty, rich, meat dishes.

33. MONICA DI SARDEGNA 'Perdera' 2020

£34.95

Argiolas, Cagliari, Sardinia, Italy

Perdera, meaning "place of many stones," is made from Monica, a grape grown exclusively on the island of Sardinia. This native variety has bright acidity, low tannins with flavours of cherries and plums underpinned by floral and spicy notes. Juicy, soft and easy to drink, rarely seen on wine lists, but very popular in its native land.

34. VACQUEYRAS Cuvée Floureto 2019

£44.95

Domaine Le Sang des Cailloux, Southern Rhône, France

The name of this domaine translates as 'the blood of the stones'. This refers to the famous rounded stones ('galets roulés') found in the vineyards of this region but is also entirely appropriate given the meticulous care and attention that winemaker Serge Ferigoule lavishes on his wines. They have everything we love about the Rhone - dark and wild with notes of leather, spicy garrigue herbs and smoky black fruit. They are bottled unfiltered and unfined giving a wonderful rich, velvety texture. Serge is a touch sentimental and each year his Cuvée Traditionelle is named for one of his three daughters, Floureto, Doucinello and Azalaïs.



Red Wines

Full bodied, more complex reds

35. MONASTRELL Old Vine, Tarima Hill, 2019/20

£35.95

Bodegas Volver, Rodriguillo-pinoso, D.O. Alicante, Spain

Made by one of Spain's most innovative winemakers, this is an outstanding 100% Monastrell (Mourvedre) made from old vines at high altitude between Alicante's main mountain ranges. Aged in French oak for twenty months, it is packed with deep brooding blueberries and blackberry fruit with a touch of chocolate. This wine has exceeded our expectations.

Robert Parker 91 points (An outstanding wine of exceptional complexity and character.)

36. RIOJA CRIANZA, 'Cerro Anon', 2019

£34.95

Bodegas Olarra, Logrono, Rioja Alta, Spain

A traditional Riojan blend that offers crisp raspberry aromas which follow onto the palate supportedby layers of spiciness from the ageing mainly American oak. A firm yet velvety mouthfeel and long clean finish—a well balanced wine.

37. RIPASSA VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE, 2018

£44.95

Zenato, Peschiera del Garda, Verona, Italy

A Ripassa wine shares many of the characteristics of Amarone. This is an intense, rounded, velvet-textured wine with rich, complex aromas of berries and an impressively lengthy finish that seems to linger forever. A superb wine that is perfect with richer foods and, to be frank, outstanding with cheeses too.

38. MALBEC Secret 2019

£47.50

Finca Eugenio Bustos, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina

One of the best reds from South America that we have ever tried. There is an astonishing concentration of rich fruit, Asian spices, dark chocolate and liquorice, underpinned by sweet vanilla (from careful maturation in oak barrels) and a zesty acidity. Silky, medium-bodied and stuffed with uber-ripe fruit, this wine doesn't need any validation but we ought to point out that it won the Malbec Trophy at the International Wine Challenge!

39. SEMILLON Helmsford Vineyard, 2019

£ 37.95

Paulett Wines, Clare Valley, Australia

Mirabelle plums and greengage on the nose leads to a fresh palate with overtones of tropical fruits. The fruits continue onto the palate concluding with a long and intriguing finish demonstrating that the Clare Valley can grow decent Semillon.

40. PINOT GRIS, 'Roaring Meg' 2021

£ 35.00

Mount Difficulty Estate, Bannockburn, Central Otago, New Zealand

With an intense and inviting bouquet of almond blossom, pear, passion fruit and fresh ginger with a full and rich flavoured palate of white peach and crunchy green pear, this vibrant wine has an off-dry, succulent and long finish.

41. ROUSSANNE, 'Samuel's Garden' 2019/20

£ 37.95

Yalumba Wines, Eden Valley, South Australia

Aromas of wild flowers, chamomile, lavender and wild rose. A silky yet rich and structured wine with white fleshed peach and vanilla layered over fresh grapefruit with lingering hints of honeycomb.

42. CHARDONNAY, Te Mata Estate, 2020

£ 39.50

Havelock North, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

Ripe peach and white flower aromas unfurl on to a palate full of stone fruits and creamy nuttiness, As well as notes of toast and biscuits from the oak. Fine and dry with a lovely clean finish.

Red Wines

43. BAROSSA GSM (Grenache/Syrah/Mataro) 2018

£ 35.95

Yalumba Wines, Barossa Valley, South Australia

Lovely garnet red in colour. Aromas of plums and wild blackberry mingling with milk chocolate and smoky spice make this wine instantly appealing. The palate is full of sweet, silky, dark berry fruit and mocha chocolate finishing with beautifully plush tannins.

44. CABERNET SAUVIGNON 'Filius' 2019

£ 39.95

Vasse Felix, Margaret River, Western Australia

Fragrances of plum and mulberry, with cassis, hints of iodine and five spice give aromatic detail. Its lovely fresh acidity and fine, crisp, sinewy tannins accompanies flavours of blackcurrant compote with lovely dusty earthiness and hint of nutmeg and a soft, elegant core.

45. SYRAH Te Mata Estate, 2019

£ 40.95

Havelock North, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

Abundant dark fruits, violets and herbs on the nose with a supple, savoury palate with characteristic black pepper, layered with exotic spices and hints of cocoa.

46. PINOT NOIR 'Estate Wine' 2019/20

£ 49.95

Mount Difficulty, Bannockburn, Central Otago, New Zealand

Vibrant aromas of cherry and berries, complemented by a subtle hint of spice from the careful use of oak. An energetic palate of red cherry, strawberry and black plums leads to a long finish framed by firm, fine tannins. Really demonstrates this region 's ability to produce world class Pinots!

White Wines

47H. CHABLIS 1er Cru 'Mont de Milieu' 2018

Domaine Pinson, Chavignol, Loire, France

Acacia and lime on the nose with a hint of spice, this incredibly powerful offering from one of the 'senior' estates in Chablis, has a terrific concentration of vibrant, racy fruit and superb minerality.

48H. CHÂTEAU HAUT RIAN, 2020

Bordeaux Blanc, Rions, Bordeaux, France

Fully dry but packed with ripe, rich gooseberry flavour and a wonderful zesty balancing acidity. A perfect aperitif, which happily accompanies creamy chicken and fish dishes. This is a blend of 70% Sémillon and 30% Sauvignon Blanc.

Red Wines

49H. CHATEAU MUSAR, 2016

Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

The palate is very intense and concentrated, full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy and it has a lengthy finish.
