*Fresher and fruitier than ever. This Manzanilla is elegant, pungent and nutty with a delightful tangy salty finish. The perfect way to start your evening.*

#### **AMONTILLADO DELGADO ZULETA [Medium dry sherry]**

Delgado Zuleta, Andalucia, Spain (abv 17.5%)

*Wonderful, intensely complex Amontillado which is not completely dry. Concentrated, salty, nutty flavours are the result of long ageing in old soleras, within sight of the sea.*

#### **OLOROSO ABOCADO 'Alameda' [Cream sherry]**

Javier Hidalgo, Bodegas Hidalgo, Sanlucar de Barrameda, Spain (abv 18%)

*For those looking for a sweeter Oloroso, the Abocado is a blend of old soleras with high-quality Pedro Ximenez; it is dark and concentrated with a very long finish. These are all sherries which represent the most traditional side of the market and are the purest examples of what the Jerezanos drink themselves.*

#### **DRY WHITE PORT**

*This is a White Port that makes a statement. Full flavoured with a dry nutty finish, its naturally rich, golden colour is the result of 10 years' ageing in wood. *Fabulous intensely aromatic, crisp, Estate grown wine, reflecting the world famous Marlborough style. The 2023 Estate Sauvignon Blanc has an attractive nose of zesty lemon and passionfruit tied together with fresh, herbaceous layers. The palate has wonderful gooseberry fruit concentration with mineral undertones, balanced by a fresh acidity*

*Established in 1941, Robertson Winery is recognised today as one of South Africa's leading cellars. This is full-bodied, with luscious flavours of tropical fruits, ripe green figs and melon, followed by a mouthwatering acidity and a crisp, clean finish.*

Maison Bretonnière, Le Landreau, Loire, France (abv 12%)  
*A truly memorable Muscadet from one of the most highly-regarded villages in the region. Pale in colour with distinctive white flower and green apple aromas. The palate is hyper-fresh and crisp yet with a wonderful richness and a great depth of fruit.*
- 10. BORDEAUX BLANC, 2024** **£39.00**

Chateau Haut Rian, Bordeaux, France  
*Dry, fresh and packed with rich gooseberry flavour along with a wonderful fresh zesty acidity that balances the fruit, providing a ripe mouth-filling experience.*
- 11. CHABLIS, 2023** **£52.00**

Domaine Pinson, Chablis, France  
*Bright, vibrant, pure, refreshing, aromatic, loaded with 'goût de pierre à fusil' (gunflint taste), and perfectly balanced between ripe fruit and lemony, green apple, acidity.*
- 12. VERMENTINO di Sardegna, 2025** **£42.00**

Costamolino, Argiolas Estate, Cagliari, Sardinia  
*Subtle, delicate and beautifully dry, this Vermentino is, we think, outstanding. Argiolas personifies Sardinia, due in part to the family's devotion to indigenous Sardinian grape varieties. Their passion is shared by the famous oenologist Professor Giacomo Tachis, the father of prestigious Italian wines such as Sassicaia, Tignanello and Solaia, who has worked closely with the Argiolas family for over a decade now.*
- 12a DART VALLEY RESERVE 2023** **£40.00**

Sandridge Barton, Totnes, Devon  
*Off-dry, ever popular, elegant white from South Devon. Made from Madeleine Angevine, Chardonnay and Bacchus grapes grown on the banks of the River Dart. This is a great aperitif wine and an ideal accompaniment to fish.*

- 13. ALBARINO, 'Gran Fabian' 2024** **£39.50**

Bodegas Sobreira, Pontevedra, Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain  
*From a family-owned winery situated in a beautiful location where the Salnes Valley meets the Atlantic. This is a very fresh Albarino with white peach, melon and citrus flavours, leading to a superb mineral 'kick' on the finish.*
- 14. THE REAL McCOY RIESLING, 2024** **£39.50**

Jordan Wine Estate, Stellenbosch, South Africa  
*Grown on the unique south-east facing cooler aspect, these vines are 30 years old and grown in decomposed granite soil. This sensitive and aromatic variety has been made with a hint of natural sugars and wonderful intense flavours of lime through to white peach and green apple. The balancing acidity makes it a perfect match to foods with some spice & white fish dishes. Utterly divine with crab and shellfish.*

Richer, more complex whites

- 16. MACON DAVAYE, Les Belouzes, 2024** **£42.50**  
Domaine Guy Saumaize, Burgundy, France  
*Pale yellow and brilliant white Burgundy with an intense, fresh aroma and hints of citrus and ripe fruit. A nice minerality on the palate gives way to a persistent finish. Careful winemaking is the trademark of the Saumaize family giving their wines elegance and concentrated fruit flavours.*
- 17. PINOT GRIS, 2024** **£36.50**  
Villa Wolf, Pfalz, Germany  
*Ernst Loosen - of 'Dr Loosen' Mosel Riesling fame - took over this wine estate in the nineties and under his expert guidance it has gone from strength to strength. Their Pinot Gris has an opulent weight to it but retains a beautiful crisp freshness. Ripe pear and stone fruit abound with a hint of white pepper spice and a lovely zesty lift of lemony acidity.*
- 18. ROUSSANNE 'Samuel's Garden' 2024** **£42.00**  
Yalumba Wines, Eden Valley, South Australia  
*Aromas of wild flowers, chamomile, lavender and wild rose. A silky yet rich and structured wine with white fleshed peach and vanilla layered over fresh grapefruit with lingering hints of honeycomb.*
- 19. CHARDONNAY 'Le Baron' 2024** **£44.50**  
Domaine Saint Hilaire, Montagnac, Pays d'Oc, France  
*A sumptuous, rich, barrel-fermented Chardonnay from this picturesque and historic estate tucked away in the beautiful Hérault countryside. Named after the first Baron, Hilaire Reynaud, 'Chardonnay Le Baron' is made from hand-picked grapes carefully selected from the best parcels of 30 -35 year old vines which have exceptionally low yields and give intensely flavoured, concentrated juice. Delicately floral aromas of garrigue honey, lead to a palate of brioche typical of a Chardonnay resulting from a long ageing. This artisanal wine seduces with its elegance comparable to the great Burgundian wines.*

*Intense, brilliant garnet red in colour. On the nose, finesse and elegance with notes of dried flowers and very ripe red fruits, and delicate tannins on the palate flowing into a salivating finish. All in all a silky, soft Fleurie with real precision and underlying concentration, giving it great length.*
- 21. PINOT NOIR, 'Serbal' 2024** **£38.50**  
 Bodegas Atamisque, Tupungatao, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina  
*With this wine, it's all about the fruit, no oak, and pure varietal character. Elegant, poised with a very fruity nose offering overtones of cherry and strawberry. A soft, velvety palate with a suggestion of smokiness and a good fruity finish. A delightful Pinot Noir that would give low-end Burgundy a run for its money.*
- 22. MARANGES 1er CRU, 'Les Loyeres' 2024** **£52.00**  
 Château de la Charrière, Domaine Yves Girardin, Burgundy, France  
*With a brilliant garnet red colour, this is a great example of Pinot Noir from one of the less well known villages of the Cotes de Beaune. On the nose, ripe fruit aromas and toasted notes are to the fore. The palate is rounded and full with rich, gentle tannins and fine spicy notes which persist in the mouth-filling finish.*

**23. CÔTES DU RHÔNE Cuvée Terre Nature, 2022** **£38.00**

Domaine Roche-Audran, Buisson, Southern Rhone, France

A deliciously fresh and silky Grenache/Syrah blend from the Organic and Biodynamic estate of talented Rhône winemaker, Vincent Rochette. Packed full of vibrant berry fruit infused with garrigue herbs, the 'Cuvée Nature' undergoes a long, slow vinification before being bottled in the spring with no added Sulphur to preserve the flavour and freshness of this cuvée.

**24. CHÂTEAU LA PASSONNE, 2022** **£37.50**

Bordeaux, France

Situated in the commune of Cadillac, on the opposite bank of the Garonne to the Graves and Sauternes, this Premières Côtes de Bordeaux has been something of a find. Made by Michel Bonot and Louis-Michel Muyst, of Château Carbon d'Artigues, in the Graves, this is an outstanding claret with plenty of easy, succulent fruit, a good structure provided by very soft, ripe tannins and a long finish. It is complex and juicy and quite delicious, and shows that modest red Bordeaux can provide some terrific drinking if carefully made by passionate artisan-craftsmen.

**25. TOURIGA NACIONAL 'Forma de Arte', 2023** **£37.00**

Casal Monteiro, Tejo, Portugal

Made exclusively from estate-grown Touriga Nacional grapes. harvested at the ideal maturation point. This unoaked, concentrated and fully aromatic wine has great structure and complexity, with bags of juicy black fruit flavours, and a persistent finish.

Very food friendly, especially with weighty, rich, meat dishes.

**26. MONICA DI SARDEGNA 'Perdera', 2024** **£39.50**

Argiolas, Cagliari, Sardinia, Italy

Perdera, meaning "place of many stones," is made from Monica, a grape grown exclusively on the island of Sardinia. This native variety has bright acidity, low tannins with flavours of cherries and plums underpinned by floral and spicy notes. Juicy, soft and easy to drink, rarely seen on wine lists, but very popular in its native land.

**27. MONASTRELL Old Vine, Tarima Hill, 2022**

**£42.00**

Bodegas Volver, Pinoso, D.O. Alicante, Spain

*Made by one of Spain's most innovative winemakers, this is an outstanding 100% Monastrell (Mourvedre) made from old vines at high altitude between Alicante's main mountain ranges. Aged in French oak for twenty months, it is packed with deep brooding blueberries and blackberry fruit with a touch of chocolate. This wine has exceeded our expectations.*

*Robert Parker 91points (An outstanding wine of exceptional complexity and character.)*

**28. SHIRAZ Selkirk, 2021**

**£44.00**

Bremerton, Langhorne Creek, South Australia

*Deliciously satisfying Aussie Shiraz, the Selkirk offers rich dark berry and plum fruit with classic varietal notes of white pepper and savoury spice. Balanced and well-structured with soft supple tannins and well-integrated oak.*

**29. RIPASSA VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE, 2021**

**£52.50**

Zenato, Peschiera del Garda, Verona, Italy

*A Ripassa wine shares many of the characteristics of Amarone. This is an intense, rounded, velvet-textured wine with rich, complex aromas of berries and an impressively lengthy finish that seems to linger forever. A superb wine that is perfect with richer foods and, to be frank, outstanding with cheeses too.*

**30. MALBEC Secret, 2021**

**£49.50**

Finca Eugenio Bustos, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina

*One of the best reds from South America that we have ever tried. There is an astonishing concentration of rich fruit, Asian spices, dark chocolate and liquorice, underpinned by sweet vanilla (from careful maturation in oak barrels) and a zesty acidity. Silky, medium-bodied and stuffed with uber-ripe fruit, this wine doesn't need any validation but we ought to point out that it won the Malbec Trophy at the International Wine Challenge!*

**40H. SAINT VERAN, Vieilles Vignes, 2023**

HALF: **£30.50**

Domaine G Saumaize, Burgundy, France

Acacia and lime on the nose with a hint of spice, this delicious Maconnais wine has vibrant, racy fruit, a lovely minerality, and a creamy finish.

**41H. CHÂTEAU HAUT RIAN, 2024**

HALF: **£25.50**

Bordeaux Blanc, Rions, Bordeaux, France

Fully dry but packed with ripe, rich gooseberry flavour and a wonderful zesty balancing acidity.

A perfect aperitif, which happily accompanies creamy chicken and fish dishes.

This is a blend of 60% Sémillon and 40% Sauvignon Blanc.

**42H. CHATEAU MUSAR, 2019**

Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

*The traditional Musar blend of approximately one third each of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault and Carignan. Dark blood red colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose of mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. The palate is very intense and concentrated, full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy and it has a lengthy finish.*

**43H. LA DAME d'ANGLUDET, 2021**

HALF: **£39.50**

**Margaux** - Château Angludet, Bordeaux, France

*La Dame d'Angludet is the second wine of renowned Margaux estate, Chateau Angludet.*

*An approachable, fruit-forward style, crafted from younger vines (typically 6–15 years old) but still receiving all the skill and attention lavished on the Grand Vin. Lush dark fruit with hints of liquorice and spice, and firm but supple tannins - this younger sibling is a great introduction to the style of Chateau d'Angludet. [Cabernet Sauvignon 45% - Merlot 45% - Petit Verdot 10%]*

Here, the Sémillon (80%) and Sauvignon Blanc (20%) combine harmoniously to offer a highly expressive bouquet of citrus notes and marmalade fruit with a hint of honey. Incredible length and complexity.*
